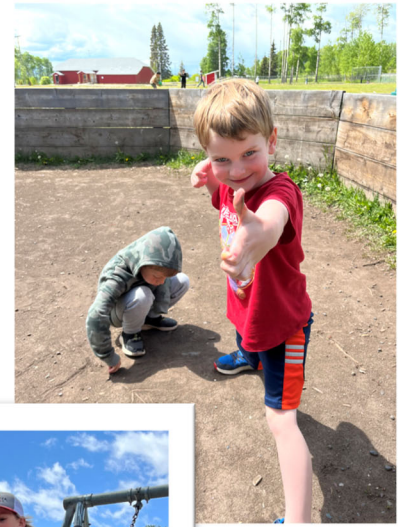


Congratulations from all the staff and students at Francois Lake Elementary!
