Wow! What a fabulous start to the 2023-2024 school year! Francois Lake School would like to welcome all families (new and returning) to our school. Students are adjusting to routines in classrooms and are engaging in learning new and exciting concepts.

The 2023-2024 school year will have some changes for parents as we implement the BC Ministry of Education and Childcare's Reporting Order. Parents and students can expect the following:

Between September 25-29, 2023, all students will set personal goals for each of the competency statements. The School District 91 Competency Statements are:

- O Communication: We can speak and listen actively and respectfully.
- O Thinking: We can reflect, evaluate and grow in our own thinking and actions.
- O Personal and Social: We can show respect and inclusive behaviour as we learn and play.

These goals will be revisited at the end of each term and students will compete a self assessment of their progress in relation to their goals. A copy of these goals will be sent home to all caregivers with formal learning updates. Caregivers are encouraged to discuss learning goals with students and discuss progress with them.

On **October 12, 2023**, **Informed Learning (IL) Reports** about student achievement will go home. On **October 18, 2023**, there will be our **Talk About Learning** afternoon.

More information about these changes will be forwarded to parents as it becomes available.

I would like to encourage all parents and caregivers to get involved in their child's education. One way to do this is to attend monthly **PAC** meetings. Our next PAC meeting will be **Wednesday September 20th following the Francois Lake Open House**. Babysitting will be available for families at no charge. Your participation at meetings is appreciated, as is your involvement in volunteering at PAC sponsored events at the school.

I'm looking forward to this academic year as we work together; staff, students and parents working together will bring a wonderful year of learning excitement and academic growth for all students.


