PRE-REGISTRATION FOR KINDERGARTEN OR GRADE 1 APPLICATIONS

Pre-registration for children who will be entering Kindergarten or children who will be entering Grade 1 at Francois Lake Elementary (FLES) LAKES in September 2025 will take place March 17 – 21, 2025, at the times listed below.

NOTE: Students who will be entering Grade 1 in September 2025 and who are presently enrolled in Kindergarten at FLES need NOT register.

FLES Registration Requirements:

- Kindergarten students must be five (5) years old by December 31, 2025.
- Grade 1 students must be six (6) years old by December 31, 2025.
- Please bring the child's 'Care Card' or 'BC Services Card' and birth certificate. We encourage immunization to be up to date prior to starting school. Inquiries regarding immunization can be made by contacting the Health Unit.

*** Out-of-Catchment applications will not be accepted at Francois Lake Elementary School this year due to enrolment considerations. *
